



The Frank Simpson Residential Scholarship – Wesley College, University of Sydney.

In 2009 Wesley College Foundation will once again offer the Frank Simpson Scholarship. This scholarship has been established through the generous gift of Mr Frank Simpson a resident of the College from 1939-42. Frank attended Newcastle Boys' High School and was awarded 3 scholarships to study at the University of Sydney and to reside at Wesley College and his brother-in-law, Colyn Harrison had a similar experience, receiving a Coal Board Scholarship. Mr Simpson wanted to support students who wish to study Medicine, particularly those prepared to practice in country and regional centres where the need is greatest.

The scholarship is open to students who are enrolled in the MBBS graduate-entry medical degree at the University of Sydney, The successful applicant must also establish a financial need to hold the scholarship. This will be understood to mean that "but for the scholarship" the student would not be able to attend Wesley College.

Preference will be given to applicants holding a Bonded Medical Place at Sydney University, however others enrolled in the MBBS graduate-entry course who have a commitment to rural practice, may apply.

The Scholarship is to the value of full residential fees for a student – in 2009 approx \$14,000 per annum and the award is taken as a discount against College fees. The closing date for this Scholarship is 30th January, 2009. The Scholarship will be awarded for up to two years and will be reviewed annually. Up to two scholarships will be offered in 2009 and again in 2010.
