NOMINATION PROCEDURE

1. The completed nomination form must be received by 5pm Friday 15th March 2019, by either mail addressed to "The Returning Officer, Wesley College, Western Avenue, University of Sydney, NSW 2006 or in pdf emailed to lsutherland@wesleycollege-usyd.edu.au

2. Each nomination paper must be signed by at least:

(i) 2 members of Council, OR

(ii) 2 persons qualified to vote under the Wesley College Incorporation Act.

Each nomination paper must include a written statement signed by the person nominated signifying their consent to the nomination.

3. A Candidate is duly qualified under the Wesley College By-laws to be elected a Councillor if either:

(a) that person is above the age of 18 years and is a member of the Uniting Church in Australia; or

(b) an Old Collegian and a graduate of the University of Sydney ; or

(c) a member of the teaching or administration staff of the University of Sydney.

4. The length of tenure is four years with a maximum period of eight years.

5. Two vacancies are open in 2019 – one position in the Old Collegian category and one position in the Church member category.

ELECTION PROCEDURE

6. The Annual Meeting, at which the election results are to be confirmed, is to be conducted on 2nd May 2019.

7. A postal ballot will be conducted if nominations exceed vacancies. Ballot papers will be emailed or posted to all Old Collegians who are graduates of the University of Sydney and who continue to be on the books of the College. The Wesley College By-laws defines a person who is duly qualified to vote as a Voting Collegian viz. "any graduate of the University of Sydney who continues to be on the books of the College".

8. The completed ballot paper form must be received by post or email by the Returning Officer, Wesley College, University of Sydney, NSW 2006, by 5pm Friday 26 April 2019.
