Scholarships are awarded as discounts against the residential College fees. Some fees cover the value of half fees, full fees or other monetary value.

HOW TO APPLY

1. Visit wesleycollege-usyd.edu.au/scholarships (after you have completed the residency application)
2. Complete the online application form. Communication is via email so please ensure you have provided an email address that you will be accessing when offers come out (in December)
3. Provide a copy of your parents most recent tax assessment or other proof of income
4. Submit your application form
5. Advise us of your ATAR as soon as it's available.
